The Franklin County Conservation District is a political subdivision of state government, established in 1941 and charged with the conservation of the natural resources of Franklin County. Our primary operating funds are provided exclusively through county ad-valorem tax funds, as appropriated through the Franklin County Commissioners; and Kansas Water Plan funds, as outlined in K.S.A. 2-1907C. The public can also contribute to the conservation district through memorial, honorarium and other gifts to help enhance our mission of conserving our natural resources for the future.

Conservation provides economic and environmental benefits direct to Franklin County and all residents; both urban and rural. Voluntary conservation practices enhance and protect water quality, and soil health, for community health and environmental benefits and now is your opportunity to support our conservation work in Franklin County. Your tax-deductible contributions will make a difference in our public information and education programs focused on promoting conservation of natural resources for the future. All contributions received by the Franklin County Conservation District stay right here in Franklin County and will be used for the direct promotion of conservation of our natural resources in Franklin County.
