Payment in the form of a check from the State of Kansas will be mailed to the address provided on this application. All incomplete contracts are CANCELLED on May 22. A contract holder receiving \$600 or more in cost-share assistance will receive Form 1099-G from the State of Kansas. Cost share payments are subject to the State of Kansas Set off Program for payment of delinquencies to the State of Kansas.

If funds remain available after July 1, applications that were completed after February 28 will be ranked and reviewed monthly. Applications are NOT accepted in December.
